This is how the interior design project for the tandem restaurant came about, an aesthetic contamination rooted in the gastronomic fusion cuisine offered by Thierry Marx's former sous-chefs, Cédric and William. The customer's visual experience begins with the minimalist gold-coloured sterilisations that accompany the eye through the first part of the restaurant; it then continues in the central corridor with the same tropical motifs and culminates in the large dining room, with a blue forest that harmonises the colours of the walls, creating a chromatic continuum.

The living room of this freshly renovated flat in Milan has been transformed thanks to this decoration that begins at dawn and ends at sunset. The walls come together in a chromatic embrace, with warm, luminous colours at the start, gradually evolving into cool, darker hues. But this decoration is much more than just a painting; it's a tribute to the family who live here. Their initials are hidden among the leaves and the little birds dancing on the wall are the canaries their grandmother loved so much. The title of this work is "In sul calar del sole... là dove si perde il giorno", an extract from a poem by Leopardi that perfectly captures the magical atmosphere of this stay. The owners were a constant source of inspiration, helping to make this project unique and tailor-made for them.

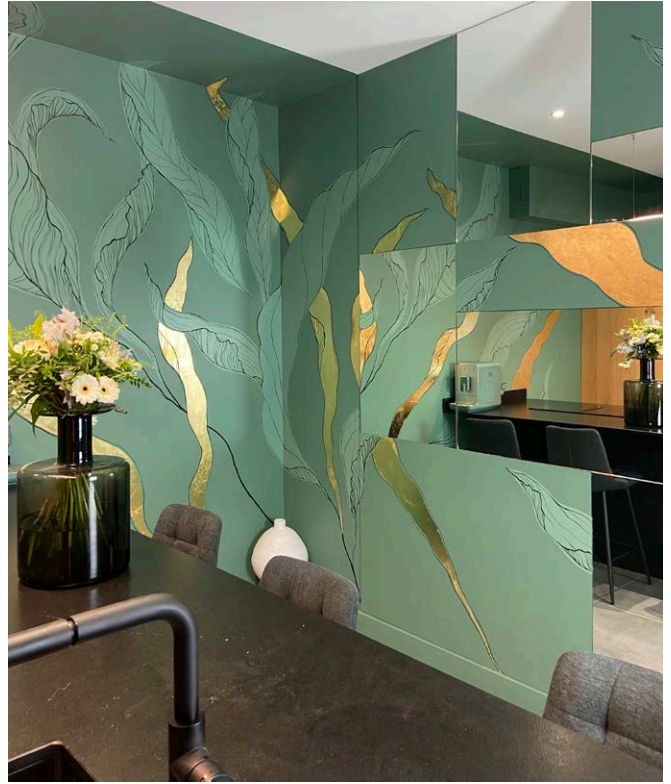

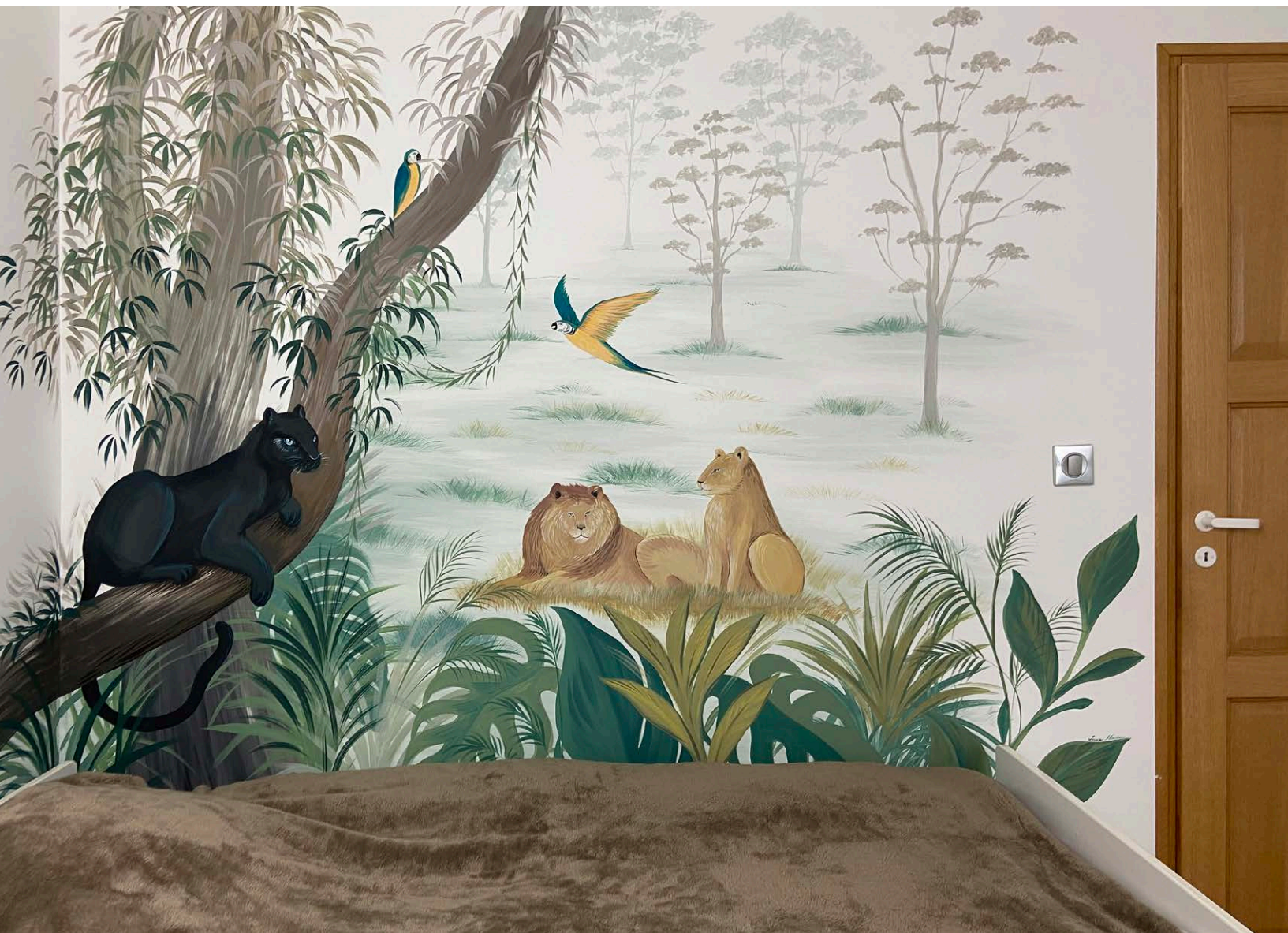

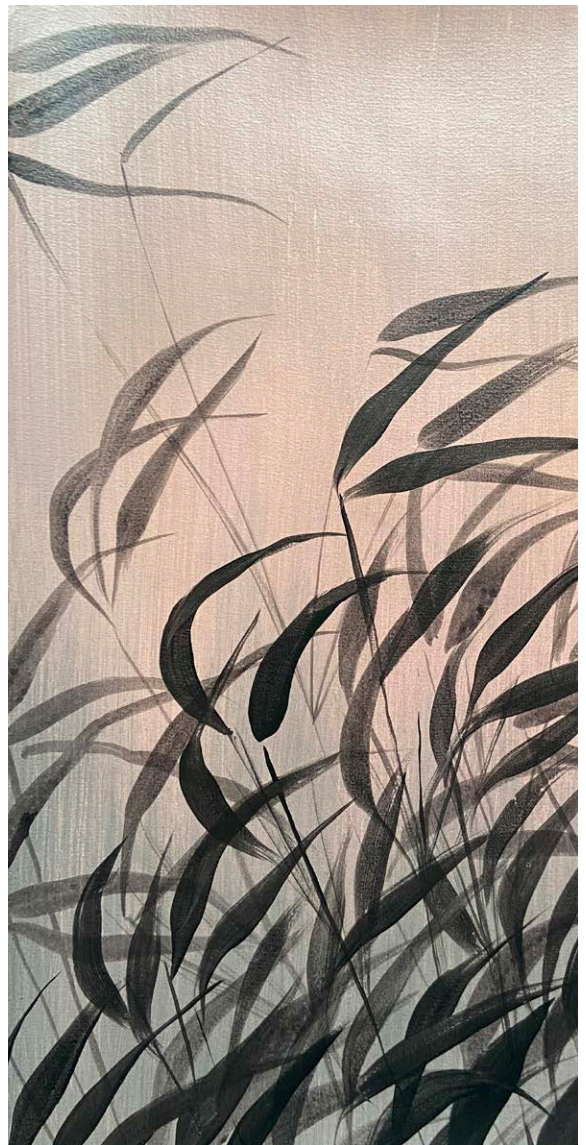
